1 2 3 4 5 6 7	An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending Section 9-1.1 <i>Election districts</i> of the Code of Ordinances by redistricting the City of Gainesville into four ratably or equally proportioned election districts as required by law; making findings; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.
8 9	WHEREAS, Section 2.02 of the Charter of the City of Gainesville provides that the City
10	Commission shall, by ordinance, adjust the boundary lines of the election districts by ordinance
11	whenever, in its judgment, the districts are not ratably or equally proportioned in accordance
12	with federal and state law, but not less frequently than within the second year following each
13	decennial census; and
14	WHEREAS, the City Commission in 2002 apportioned the City into four consecutively
15	numbered election districts using the 2000 census data and other relevant information; and
16	WHEREAS, the City Commission in March 2012 appointed the Citizen Election District
17	Review Committee consisting of residents of the City of Gainesville to recommend a plan to
18	apportion the City into four consecutively numbered election districts using the 2010 census data
19	and other relevant information; and
20	WHEREAS, the City retained the services of an expert consultant to advise the Citizen
21	Election District Review Committee and the City Commission in reviewing the census data and
22	other relevant information and to make recommendations based upon that data and other relevant
23	information; and
24	WHEREAS, the Citizen Election District Review Committee held five (5) public
25	meetings (advertised on the City's official notice of meetings and website) and one (1) public

hearing (advertised with at least ten (10) days notice in the Gainesville Sun, the Alligator,

1	Community 12TV, and the City's website) to review information and receive public comment;
2	and
3	WHEREAS, the professional consultant and the Citizen Election District Review
4	Committee recommend the apportionment of the City into four election districts as set forth
5	herein; and
6	WHEREAS, the City Commission held a public hearing on October 18, 2012 to review
7	the recommendations of the expert consultant and the Citizen Election District Review
8	Committee and receive comment from the public; and
9	WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given by publication in a newspaper of
10	general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of public hearings in the
11	Auditorium of City Hall in the City of Gainesville; and
12	WHEREAS, the public hearings were held pursuant to the published notice described at
13	which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact,
14	heard;
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
16	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
17	Section 1. Section 9-1.1 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville is amended
18	to read as follows:
19	Sec. 9-1.1. Election districts.
20	(a) In accordance with section 2.02 of the Charter of the city, the following election districts
21	are hereby established for the purpose of representation upon and election of four
22	members to the city commission:
23	District No. 1

- District No. 1 shall be comprised of the following precincts: Precinct Nos. 13, 16, 19, 25, 28, 29,
- 2 33 and 55 13, 19, 25, 28, 30, 33, 34, 55, and 59.
- District No. 2
- District No. 2 shall be comprised of the following precincts: Precinct Nos. 12, 17, 21, 37, 38, 45,
- 5 57, 58, 61 and 64 12, 17, 21, 22, 37, 38, 45, 50, and 57.
- 6 District No. 3
- District No. 3 shall be comprised of the following precincts: Precinct Nos. 4, 24, 26, 32, 36, 40,
- 8 44, 48 and 54 24, 26, 32, 36, 39, 40, 43, 48, 52, 54, and 61.
- 9 District No. 4
- District No. 4 shall be comprised of the following precincts: Precinct Nos. 5, 7, 23, 27, 31 and 59
- 5, 7, 23, 27, 31, and 44.
- 12 A map identifying the election districts is attached to the ordinance from which this section
- derives as Exhibit A for illustrative purposes only and is on file in the office of the clerk of the
- 14 commission.
- 15 (b) As used in this section, the term "precincts" means the county election precincts of
- Alachua County, Florida, as established by the board of county commissioners and
- approved by the supervisor of elections. The boundaries of said precincts are the
- boundaries as they exist on the effective date of the ordinance from which this section
- derives or any amendatory ordinance, but only to the extent that they are located within
- the corporate limits of the city.
- Section 2. The City Commission hereby finds and determines that the four election
- 22 districts established herein are ratably or equally proportioned in accordance with the
- 23 Constitutions of the United States and of the State of Florida.

1	Section 3. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of
2	this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of
3	Gainesville, Florida, and that the sections and paragraphs of this ordinance may be renumbered
4	or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.
5	Section 4. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section, or provision of this ordinance
6	or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such
7	findings shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given
8	effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application, and to this end the
9	provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
10	Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of
11	such conflict hereby repealed.
12	Section 6. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption.


