



C-CEC Project Origin

- A 2007 vision and brainchild of founder Patricia Lee... born of an entrepreneurial training program she conceived, won grant funding for and led while serving as Executive Director of East Gainesville Development Corporation.
- Recognized that while short-term, classroom training was essential, it fell short of providing the infrastructure, financial, and technical support needs of historically low and moderate- income micro-entrepreneurs.
- Concern was that the training alone actually doomed participants to failure, disappointment, and disillusionment rather than set them up for sustained success.
- ► Failure for this particular target group would be and is typically more devastating than other emerging entrepreneurs and harder to recover from.
- Recognized that the entrepreneurial training component of C-CEC could be the base for addressing other need issues in Gainesville and beyond, particularly the East side of Gainesville and Alachua County

Project Approach and Update

- Have worked diligently to inform and engage potential collaborators on this project since returning to Gainesville in 2017. Successful in gaining buy-in from numerous capable supporters
- ▶ Look forward to "Heavenly Seven" support as C-CEC can bolster the parental support component that is critical to efforts to help children improve academic performance.
- ► Expected Project Cost: \$8 10 million minimum (Land and Building)
