ORDINANCE NO. 100941

3 An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending section 28-
4 12 of the City of Gainesville Code of Ordinances, relating to
5 Miscellaneous Regulations, by updating and revising the list of
6 protected classes for which discrimination is prohibited; providing
7 directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a
8 repealing clause; and providing an effective date in accordance with
9 the schedule provided herein.

11 WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper
12 of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a public hearing to
13 be held in the City Commission Auditorium, City Hall, City of Gainesville; and

14 WHEREAS, the Public Hearings were held pursuant to the published notice described at
15 which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact,
16 heard.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
18 CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

19 Section 1. Section 28-12 of the Gainesville Code of Ordinances is amended by amending
20 subsection (e) to read as follows:

21 **Sec. 28-12. – Miscellaneous regulations.**

22 (e) No company or driver shall discriminate against any person or refuse to accept a
23 passenger on the basis of their sexual orientation, race, color, gender, age, religion,
24 national origin, ~~religious belief, age, sex or sexual orientation~~ marital status, disability or
25 gender identity.

26 Section 2. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1
27 shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida,
28 and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in order
29 to accomplish such intentions.

30 Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be
31 invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no
32 way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

33 Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of
34 such conflict hereby repealed.

35 Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
