001066 Industrial Zoning District Moratorium (B)

City of Gainesville Community Development Director Tom Saunders and Water and Air Research Representative Dr. Bill Zegel gave presentations.

NOTE: Mayor Paula M. DeLaney entered the meeting room at 6:22 PM and assumed the gavel.

Environmental Engineer Steve Cullen (Koogler & Associates) made comments.

MOTION: Commissioner Pegeen Hanrahan moved and Commissioner Warren Nielsen seconded that the City Commission: 1) Adopt a 6 month moratorium on the uses shown in Dr. Zegel's report in the top 3 categories in whichever zoning district they may occur; 2) ask as part of the study that staff review all potential localized impacts including truck traffic, noise, odor, dust, air emissions, water emissions, vibrations and cumulative effects; 3) that staff review issues such as proximities to other uses, and an appropriate regulatory framework to either minimize or eliminate those impacts; 4) include any of the 10 items that were on Mr. Cullen's list, but not on Dr. Zegel's list; 5) also have staff address impacts associated with category MG14 (mining and quarrying of non-metallic minerals except fuels); category 3011 (tires and innertubes); and category MG30 (gum factory) in Dr. Zegel's report.
