15	Development Code of the City of Gainesville, Florida, be amended and a public hearing was			
16	then held by the City Plan Board on March 15, 2007; and			
17	WHEREAS, notices were given and publications made of subsequent public hearings			
18	and workshops, which were held by the City Plan Board on November 29, 2007 and January 24,			
19	2008; and			
20	WHEREAS, notices were given and publications made of public hearings which were			
21	then held by the City Commission on April 23, 2007, September 24, 2007 and February 4, 2008;

23	WHEREAS, pursuant to law, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication			
24	in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a			
25	public hearing in the City Commission Auditorium, City Hall, City of Gainesville; and			
26	WHEREAS, an advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches long was			
27	placed in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of a public hearing in the City			
28	Commission meeting room, City Hall, City of Gainesville to be held at least 10 days after the

1	WHEREAS, a second advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches long
2	was placed in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of the second public
3	hearing to be held at least 5 days after the day this second advertisement was published; and
4	WHEREAS, the public hearings were held pursuant to the published notice described
5	above at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were,
6	in fact, heard;
7	WHEREAS, based on considerations of community aesthetics, traffic safety concerns
8	and the lack of recognized standards by which to appropriately regulate the emerging technology
9	of electronic signs, which considerations were discussed or made part of the record at the public
10	hearings, the City Commission finds it appropriate to prohibit electronic signs and require a
11	mandatory review within three years;
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
13	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
14	Section 1. The aforementioned finding is adopted by the City Commission of the City of
15	Gainesville.
16	Section 2. Certain definitions within section 30-23 of the Land Development Code of the
17	City of Gainesville, Florida, as fully set forth below, are amended, and the remaining definitions
18	within section 30-23 shall remain unchanged and in effect:

- 1 Sec. 30-23. Definitions.
- 2 Animated sign means any sign or device visible from the right-of-way of a public street or
- 3 <u>highway that contains text or pictorial information that moves or changes, or that uses movement</u>
- 4 or change of lighting or change of color to depict action or create a special effect or scene.
- 5 Animated sign means any sign which involves motion or rotation of any part by any means, or is
- 6 illuminated by flashing, intermittent or color-changing light or lighting.
- 7 Changing message device means any device visible from a public right of way across the face of
- 8 which a written message appears to move or containing a written message which changes
- 9 mechanically more than once in any three minutes.
- 10 Electronic sign means any sign, or portions of a sign, where any light source, including but not
- limited to incandescent bulbs or light-emitting diodes (LED), constitute the sign text or image.
- This type of sign includes, but is not limited to, electronic message boards, television screens,
- plasma screens, digital screens, flat screens, LED screens, video boards, other types of electric
- and electronic display boards and screens, and holographic displays. Electronic signs include
- projected images or messages onto buildings or other objects. Signs that are illuminated by light
- sources only for the purpose of internal or external illumination are not considered electronic
- 17 <u>signs, nor are non-animated neon signs.</u>
- Section 3. Section 30-316(b)(9) of the Land Development Code of the City of
- 19 Gainesville, Florida is amended to read as follows:

1	Sec. 30-316. General Restrictions.
2 3 4	(b) Prohibited Signs. It shall be unlawful to erect, cause to be erected, maintain or cause to be maintained any of the following signs:
5 6 7 8	 (9) Changing message devices (See section 30-23, Definitions). (9) Electronic sign(s) (see section 30-23, Definitions).
9	Section 4 . It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Sections 2
10	and 3 of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of
11	Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered
12	or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.
13	Section 5. The City Commission directs that the City Manager, or his designee, review
14	the prohibition on electronic signs and provide a report to the City Commission within three
15	years of the effective date of this ordinance. Failure to timely provide such report shall not affect
16	the validity or application of this ordinance.
17	Section 6. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance
18	or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such
19	finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given
20	effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the
21	provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
22	Section 7. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of
23	such conflict hereby repealed.
24	Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
