### ORDINANCE NO. 100698

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ordinance amending the City of Gainesville An Comprehensive Plan, Future Land Use Map; by changing the land use categories of certain property, as more specifically described in this ordinance, from the Alachua County land use categories of "Low Density Residential (1-4 DU/acre)", "Medium Density Residential (4-8 DU/acre)", "Medium High Density Residential (8-14 DU/acre)", "High Density Residential (14-24 DU/acre)", "Recreation", "Commercial" and "Institutional" to the City of Gainesville land use categories of "Urban Mixed-Use 2 (UMU-2: up to 100 units per acre)", "Conservation (CON)" and "Public Facilities (PF)"; consisting of approximately 396 acres located generally east of Interstate 75, west of Southwest 34th Street and north and south of Southwest 20th Avenue; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an effective date.

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WHEREAS, publication of notice of a public hearing was given that the Future Land Use Map be amended by changing the land use category of certain property, as more specifically described in this Ordinance, from the Alachua County land use categories of "Low Density Residential (1-4 DU/acre)", "Medium Density Residential (4-8 DU/acre)", "Medium High Density Residential (8-14 DU/acre)", "High Density Residential (14-24 DU/acre)", "Recreation", "Commercial" and "Institutional" to the City of Gainesville land use categories of "Urban Mixed-Use 2 (UMU-2: up to 100 units per acre)", "Conservation (CON)" and "Public Facilities (PF)"; and

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WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law and a public hearing was held by the City Plan Board on February 2, 2011 (continued from January 27, 2011); and

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WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law and a public hearing

29 was held by the City Commission on March 3, 2011; and

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Ī	WHEREAS, pursuant to law, an advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches
2	long was placed in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance
3	and of the Public Hearing to be held in the City Commission Meeting Room, First Floor, City Hall, in
4	the City of Gainesville at least seven (7) days after the day the first advertisement was published; and
-5	WHEREAS, pursuant to law, after the public hearing at the transmittal stage, the City of
6	Gainesville transmitted copies of this proposed change to the State Land Planning Agency; and
7	WHEREAS, a second advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches long was
8	placed in the aforesaid newspaper notifying the public of the second Public Hearing to be held at the
9	adoption stage at least five (5) days after the day the second advertisement was published; and
10	WHEREAS, public hearings were held pursuant to the published notices described above at
11	which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard.
12	WHEREAS, prior to adoption of this ordinance the City Commission has considered the
13	comments, recommendations and objections, if any, of the State Land Planning Agency.
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
15	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
16	Section 1. The Future Land Use Map of the City of Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive
17	Plan is amended by changing the land use categories of the following described properties from the
18	Alachua County land use categories of "Low Density Residential (1-4 DU/acre)", "Medium Density
19	Residential (4-8 DU/acre)", "Medium High Density Residential (8-14 DU/acre)", "High Density
20	Residential (14-24 DU/acre)", "Recreation", "Commercial" and "Institutional" to the City of
21	Gainesville land use categories of "Urban Mixed-Use 2 (UMU-2: up to 100 units per acre)",

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1	"Conservation (CON)" and "Public Facilities (PF)"				
2 3 4 5 6 7 8	The existing Alachua County land use categories on the properties are depicted on the Map attached as Exhibit "A" (consisting of 1 page) and made a part hereof as if set forth in full. The new City of Gainesville land use categories on the properties are depicted on the Maps attached as Exhibit "B" (consisting of 3 pages) and made a part hereof as if set forth in full.				
9	Section 2. The City Manager is authorized and directed to make the necessary changes in				
10	maps and other data in the City of Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive Plan, or element, or portion				
11	thereof in order to comply with this ordinance.				
12	Section 3. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or				
13	the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding				
14	shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect				
15	without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of				
16	this ordinance are declared severable.				
17	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of such				
18	conflict hereby repealed.				
19	Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage on second				
20	reading; however, the effective date of this plan amendment shall be the date a final order is issued by				
21	the Department of Community Affairs finding the amendment to be in compliance in accordance with				
22	Chapter 163.3184, F.S.; or the date a final order is issued by the Administration Commission				
23	finding the amendment to be in compliance in accordance with Chapter 163.3184, F.S.

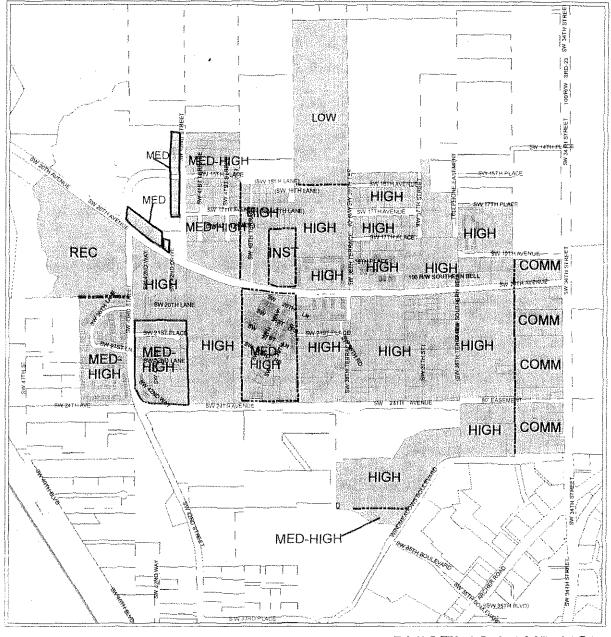

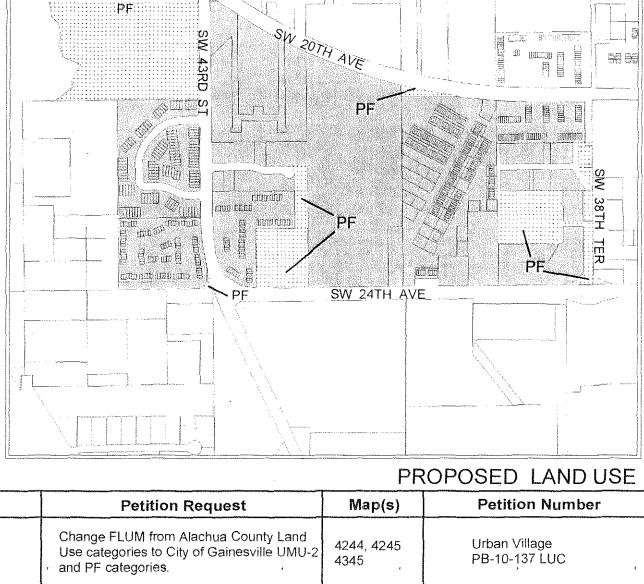

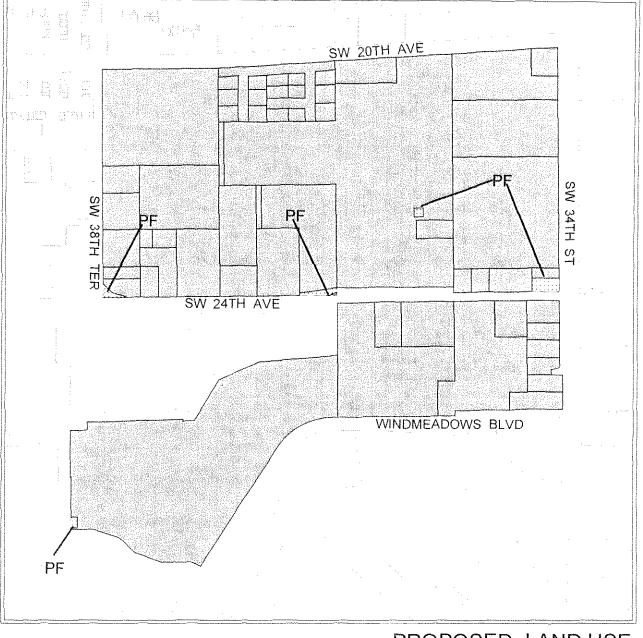

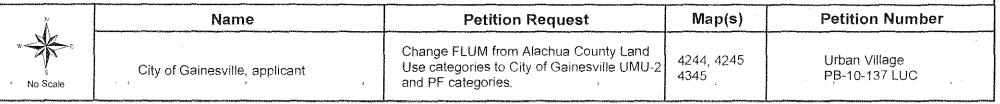


Area Proposed for UMU2 Land Use

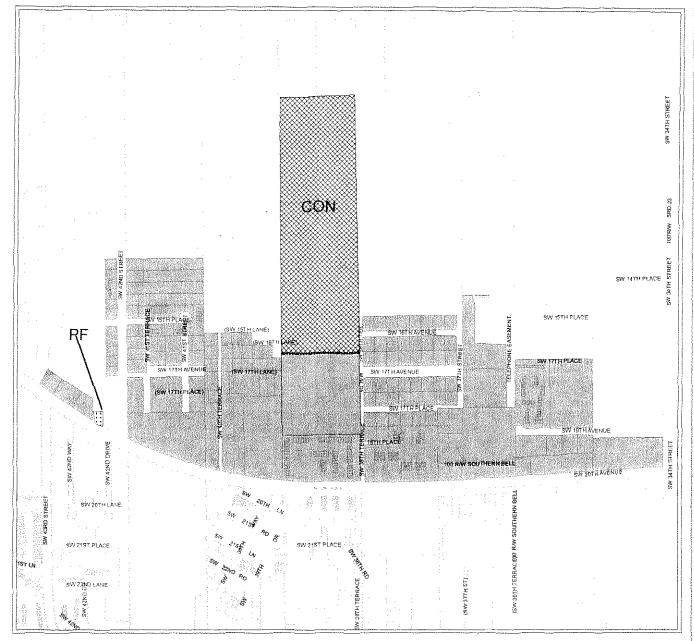
