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22	WHEREAS, the Alachua County Property Appraiser certified the 2009 taxable values to
23	the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida on July 1, 2009.
24	WHEREAS, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, requires the City Commission to advise
25	the Property Appraiser of its rolled-back millage rate, its proposed millage rate, and of the time,
26	date, and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and
27	the proposed tentative budget.
28	WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation
29	within Alachua County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the City of
30	Gainesville as \$5,896,462,408.
31	WHEREAS, on July 27, 2009, adopted Resolution No. 090207 that adopted the
32	proposed millage for the 2009-2010 fiscal year; and
33	WHEREAS, Resolution No. 090207 erroneously established the proposed operating
34	millage rate for 2009-2010 fiscal year at 4.4192 mills; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to correct and revise the proposed operating
millage rate for 2009-2010 fiscal year, as more fully set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

- **Section 1.** The proposed millage rate necessary to fund the proposed tentative general purpose municipal budget for the City of Gainesville's 2009-2010 fiscal year is 4.3963 mills.
- Section 2. The FY 2009-2010 proposed operating millage rate is 4.3963 mills, which is the rolled-back rate.
 - **Section 3.** A public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the proposed tentative budget for general municipal purposes on Thursday, September 3rd, at six o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the City Hall Auditorium on the first floor of City Hall, 200 East University Avenue, City of Gainesville, Florida.
 - **Section 4.** The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to provide a copy of this resolution to the Alachua County Property Appraiser for use in preparing the Notice of Proposed Property Taxes, as required by Section 200.069, Florida Statutes, and to execute, as the Administering Official, any Department of Revenue forms necessary to complete this certification.
 - **Section 4.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
