#### INTRODUCTION

- The Streetscape project of NW 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue is a utility streetscape partnership with CRA and GRU.
- Funding for undergrounding is shared, with CRA funding civil infrastructure and lighting and GRU funding electrical infrastructure, off site integration and utilities relocations.

#### **CRA Projects in FAPS**

- Six phase Streetscape Plan on NW 5th Ave.
  - Phase 1 Equipment Relocation (complete)
  - Phase 2 NW/SW 13th Street, remove overhead power, install underground power & decorative lighting (complete)
  - Phase 3 NW 5th Avenue Streetscape 3rd street to 6th street, remove overhead underground power & decorative lighting (under construction)



## Phase 2 – CPUH/FAPS Joint Project on NW 13<sup>th</sup> Street







#### Phase 4 – NW 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue from 6<sup>th</sup> Street to 10<sup>th</sup> Street



#### Phase 5 – NW 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue from NW 10<sup>th</sup> Street to 12 Street




## Phase 6 - NW 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue looking west from NW 12<sup>th</sup> Street



- The Scope of work is to include removal of existing sidewalks, driveways, and pavement to accommodate streetscape brick pavers, the installation of underground electric conduit for the relocation of existing overhead lines and installation of decorative lighting. The project length is 911 feet
- The accommodation of Bellsouth telephone and Cox cable TV conduit in the same trench line.
- The installation of streetscape brick sidewalks and crosswalks, sodding and final dressing as required and maintenance of traffic and temporary sidewalk detours to facilitate traffic and business operations

 On September 13, 2007 the City Purchasing Department solicited bids and four firms responded with Anglin Construction Co. being the lowest responsive responsible bidder in the amount of \$387,370.

- The Bid Award will be on the City Commission October 22, 2007 agenda for approval.
- The Contractor will have 30 days to start construction work following the issuance of the Notice to Proceed. The construction time will to compete the project will be 90 days.
