The assessment for each parcel of property will be based upon each parcel's classification and the total number of billing units attributed to that parcel.

The City Commission on June 9, 2008 adopted an Initial Rate Resolution setting the proposed fire services assessments to be assessed for the fiscal year as shown in the following schedule:


