
## NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES TO PERMITTED USES IN THE INDUSTRIAL (I-1 AND I-2) ZONING DISTRICTS AND CHANGES TO GENERAL PERFORMANCE STANDARDS

The City of Gainesville, Florida, proposes to adopt the ordinance whose title appears below. The areas covered by the proposed ordinance include the entire corporate limits of the City, and in particular, the industrial districts.

A second reading on the ordinance will be held by the City Commission on Monday, December 10, 2001, at 6:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as may be heard. The meeting will be held in the First Floor Auditorium, City Hall Building at 200 East University Avenue, Gainesville, Florida. A copy of the ordinance may be inspected by any member of the public at the office of the Clerk of the Commission located at 200 East University Avenue, Gainesville, Florida, and at the Public Library, located at 401 East University Avenue, Gainesville, Florida, during regular business hours. An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending Section 30-69 of the Land Development Code by repealing certain uses permitted by right, and by clarifying the findings for special use permits, in the "I-1: Limited industrial district"; amending Section 30-70 of the Land Development Code by repealing certain uses permitted by right, by changing certain uses to uses permitted by special use permit, and by clarifying the findings for special use permits in the "I-2: General industrial district", amending Section 30-345 of the Land Development Code entitled "General Performance Standards" by changing the standards of performance for all uses and activities in all zoning districts of the City; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.
