WHEREAS, members of IAAP's Florida Division Chapters (28 total) recognize the importance of continuing education and building business networks; and

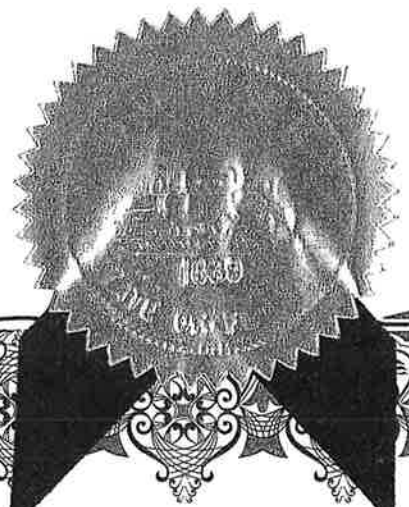
WHEREAS, the week of April 23rd through the 29th has been designated Administrative Professionals Week by the International Association of Administrative Professionals, its originator and sponsor.
