Proclamation of Mayor

To hold a referendum on the proposed annexation of an area of unincorporated Alachua County into the City of Gainesville, Florida, as provided in Ordinance No. 120307.

To hold a referendum on the proposed annexation of an area of unincorporated Alachua County into the City of Gainesville, Florida, as provided in Ordinance No. 120308.

On the election date, April 9, 2013, the polls shall be opened at 7:00 A.M. and closed at 7:00 P.M.




