18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION
19	OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
20	Section 1. Section 2-433, Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, is
21	hereby amended to read as follows:
22	Sec. 2-433. Annual audit of accounts; report to be published.
23	The city commission shall employ a certified public accountant, not connected with the
24	government of the city, to audit the accounts maintained and the financial statements
25	prepared by the city during the fiscal year. The report of the audit shall be published in a
26	newspaper printed in the city for information. The audit shall cover the period ending
27	with the thirtieth day of September of each fiscal year. The report of the audit shall be
28	furnished to the city commission as early as practicable after the thirtieth day of

2 the City's website. 3 Section 2. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 4 of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City 5 of Gainesville, Florida, and that the Section and Paragraph of this ordinance may be 6 renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions. 7 Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall 8 9 in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. 10 Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the 11 extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
