The Gainesville Police Department is requesting to provide Body Worn Cameras (BWCs) to all its sworn members and Police Service Technicians (PSTs). Currently, GPD has a contract with Axon that provides for 110 body cameras. GPD is requesting approval of a new five (5) year contract with Axon for 318 body worn cameras.

Axon will provide GPD with a credit for our current body cameras which are Series Axon Body 2 and the new contract will provide GPD with the Series Axon Body 3. The Axon Body 3 body cams represent a considerable upgrade as they can provide GPS mapping, live streaming, and a drawn handgun signal device to automatically activate the body camera and begin recording.

The new body cams will be linked via Bluetooth to any other body cams, Tasers, and handgun holsters. An officer's body camera that is not recording will automatically activate if an officer turns on their Taser or draws their firearm. In addition, the body cameras of other officers on scene and nearby will also activate if any of the listed actions above occur.

The contract with Axon provides for cloud storage of video data, redaction software, and community access portals. Each employee with a body camera will be able to download photos and videos provided by citizens. GPD will also be able share a link on social media platforms that let members of the community submit their photos or video of any incident they may have witnessed.

GPD will also enable auto-tagging for recorded video incidents that is connected to our Computer Aided Dispatch which will improve video documentation and retention. The Axon software also checks on officers' performance with regards to ensuring employees are following policy regarding body camera use.

Axon also provides access of the State Attorney's Office via Evidence.com, in which GPD shares videos and cases directly and securely with them.


Due to the many features offered by Axon that is beyond that of any other body camera provider they were selected without a bidding process. The interoperability of the body cameras to include Tasers and firearms significantly increase the chances that a critical incident will be captured on video. The increased chances of getting an incident on video will protect our employees, ensure best practices, and enhance transparency to the community we serve.

Statement of Need:

This proposed non-competitive waiver is based upon an objective review of the required product/service and appears to be in the best interest of the City. I know of no conflict of interest on my part or personal involvement in any way with this request. No gratuities, favors or compromising action have taken place. Neither has my personal familiarity with particular brands, types of equipment, materials or firms been a deciding influence on my request to waive competitive bidding on this purchase when there are other known suppliers to exist.

WHY PURCHASE BODY CAMS FOR POLICE?

There are a number of case studies which reveal that wearing body cameras has proven to reduce: 1) officer use-of-force, 2) court overtime, 3) false complaints against officers. Body-worn cameras also reduce the time officers spend doing manual report writing and paperwork, allowing them to get back into service with for efficiency.

- A year-long [study](#) on the benefits of body-worn cameras from the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department found a 37% reduction in use-of-force complaints against officers wearing body-worn cameras.
- A 2017 [study](#) by Queensland Police Service looked at the effects of BWCs being worn by officers responding to the scene of domestic and family violence incidents. The study found a 22% projected increase in reported assaults and a 60-70% decrease in police legal hearings.
- A year-long [study](#) by Cambridge University on the Rialto PD in California (more than 400 officers) studied the effects on use-of-force when officers wore Axon Flex cameras. The study found a drop in use-of-force incidents by 59% and a reduction in complaints of 87.5%.
- A [study](#) in The Journal of Law Enforcement found that body-worn cameras improve law enforcement officer report writing accuracy. In the study, officers completed their use-of-force reports first by memory, then had the opportunity to review the body camera footage. An average of 2.63 minor errors, 5.4 moderate errors, and 0.9 major errors were **corrected** by officers' BWC review.
- A six-month long [study](#) on the Denver Police Department found officers were 34% less likely to receive a complaint involving inappropriate force when body-worn cameras were present.
