### Dental Screenings 2013

- Limited to 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade
- Included all 23 Alachua County public elementary schools, Sept-Nov 2013 (n = 1,978)
- Conducted in conjunction with FluMist and other health screenings (height/weight, vision, hearing)
- UF and Santa Fe faculty, students, many volunteers






### 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Dental Screening Surveys 2011, 2012, 2013

<ul> <li>Untreated cavities:</li> </ul>	27.2%	30.5%	31.7%
<ul> <li>Caries experience:</li> </ul>	46.1%	49.0%	51.6%
<ul><li>Sealants present:</li></ul>	35.7%	36.9%	49.6%
<ul> <li>Need urgent care:</li> </ul>	5.8%	6.9%	7.9%
<ul> <li>Need early dental care:</li> </ul>	21.3%	25.0%	24.8%




## Proportion of 3<sup>rd</sup> Graders with Untreated Cavities, by School -- 2013


## Proportion of 3<sup>rd</sup> Graders with Caries Experience, by School -- 2013

### Proportion of 3<sup>rd</sup> Graders with Urgent Need for Dental Care, by School -- 2013



## Screening at WIC Center

- Dental preventive program at WIC Park Ave. center
- Collaborative among UF Coll. Dentistry, UF Coll.
   Medicine Dept. OBGYN, North Central FL WIC
- Findings:
  - Screened 192 children age 0-5
  - 48 (25%) had untreated cavities
  - 25 (32%) age 0-3 referred to UF Infant Oral Health Clinic
  - 21 of 72 children (29%) age 3-5 had untreated cavities
    - More than 2X the national prevalence for 3-5 year olds (14%)

### **Dental Sealants**

- Plastic, professionally applied material
- Seals pits and fissures on posterior teeth
- Provides physical barrier to food and bacteria in those crevices to prevent decay






# Alachua County School Sealant Program

- Partnership between UFCD and United Way of North Central Florida
- Focus on grades 2 & 6
- Most often seal permanent molars
- Use mobile equipment brought into schools

### Summary

- Dental caries remains relatively high in Alachua Co.
   3<sup>rd</sup> graders, maybe increasing?
- Sealant program resulted in large increase in prevalence of sealants among children at highest risk
- Very high prevalence of dental caries in children seen at WIC
- Need for expanded prevention at early ages
