**Retitle: Application
Code Enforcement**

✕ Permit from city manager 19-122 or *designee 19-113(a)

▪ Application from organization 19-113(a)(1)

▪ Certification of tax exempt status as charitable group 19-113(a)(1)

✕ Organization name, address, credentials

Add Requirement

✕ Name, address of local/national officer for complaints

Add Requirement

✕ Names of participants

Add Requirement

▪ Specific locations 19-113(a)(2)

▪ Dates of fundraising 19-113(a)(2)

▪ Times of fundraising 19-113(a)(2)

▪ Safety vests 119-113(a)(2)

Retitle: Requirements

▪ Additional safety measures besides vests 19-113(a)(2)

▪ \$1,000,000 insurance policy insuring city 119-113(3)

▪ Allowed no more than 3 days in calendar year 119-113(b)(1)

Retitle: Restrictions

▪ Allowed hours: 9 am to 4 pm 19-113(b)(2)

▪ No more than 4 solicitors per intersection 19-113(b)(3)

✕ Limit on number of intersections for solicitation

Add Restrictions

▪ Copy of permit on each solicitor 19-113(b)(4), 19-121

▪ Solicitors must be 18 years of age 19-113(b)(5)

▪ First complete application accepted per intersection 19-113(b)(6)

▪ Solicitors prohibited from remaining in traffic flow 19-113(c)

▪ Violations of ordinance to result in warnings, then arrests 19-113(d)

Retitle: Penalty

Review, approval, duration 19-122

▪ Various “departments may suggest conditions of approval” 19-122

▪ Approval to be based on: 19-122

▪ location (zoning)

▪ types of goods or services

▪ manner of sale

▪ Permit good for no more than 30 days 19-122

✕ *No more than 1 permit issued in a 60 day period* 19-122

Refine Restrictions

Appeals 19-123

Exemptions 19-124

▪ Fundraising conducted on premises of organization

✕ Require written permission of owner
