Article II Commercial Peddlers, Solicitors and Canvassers

Eliminate permit requirements

Add applicable, revised restrictions of Noncommercial Solicitation:

19-55(b) Limit hours to 7pm in residential areas

19-55(c) Not to impede/interfere with pedestrian/vehicular traffic

19-55(c) Not to approach residential premises posted "No Solicitation"

19-55(d) No more than one peddler/solicitor to contact one member of the public

19-55(e) Not to persist after a refusal

19-55(f) Not to harass, threaten or intimidate

Copy Penalty from Noncommercial Solicitation (19-74)

Fine of no more than \$500, and/or

Jail time not exceed 60 days

Copy Purpose and Intent (19- 51) from Noncommercial Solicitation

To preserve public safety, human life, and convenience

State Occupational Tax requirement

State licensing by State and/or County Health Departments requirement for food sales

Revise Definitions (19-16) of peddler, solicitor and canvasser

Article III Noncommercial Solicitation

Eliminate permit for sales and solicitation

Eliminate ID cards

Limit residential solicitation from 9pm to 7pm

Add street solicitation cross-reference

Address all noncommercial sales

Revise Purpose and Intent of Article V as Article III's Restrictions and Requirements:

The sale and transfer of goods by nonprofit institutions will be allowed if such fundraising activities are incidental to the primary functions of the institutions.

Retitle: Fundraising by Nonprofit Agency

Remove 3 days a year sales restriction

Address noncommercial sales sharing proceeds with commercial agency

Article V Temporary Fundraising by a Nonprofit Agency

Remove sales by nonprofit agencies to Article III

Replace Purpose and Intent (19-111) with (19-51) from Noncommercial Solicitation

Modify to omit home solicitation references

Retitle: Street Solicitations by Nonprofit Agencies

Retain permit and current restrictions

Limit number of intersections

Process as Special Event permit

Held on holiday weekend

Allowed 3 days a years

Hosted by a nonprofit organization

Identify intersections via Traffic Engineering

Consolidate at Cultural Affairs

Route through GPD
