18	elections shall run from noon of the 50th day prior to the day of the election to noon of	
19	the 46th day prior to the day of the election.; and	
20	WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a	
21	newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a

26	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION

28	Section 1. The 2009 regular election for the City of Gainesville shall be held on	

1	Tuesday, March 24, 2009; and, pursuant to Section 9-2(a) of the Code of Ordinances, the
2	date of the run-off election, if necessary, shall be Tuesday, April 14, 2009.
3	Section 2. The dates for any person who meets the eligibility requirements described
4	in Article II of the City Charter and Section 9-10 of the Code of Ordinances to become a
5	candidate in 2009 for a seat on the City Commission by filing the necessary qualifying
6	papers with the supervisor of elections shall run from noon of the 50th day prior to the day
7	of the election to noon of the 46th day prior to the day of the election. Specifically, the
8	qualifying dates shall be from noon on Monday, February 2, 2009 to noon on Friday,
9	February 6, 2009. To the extent that the qualifying dates for the 2009 general election set
10	forth herein conflict with the requirements of Section 9-10 of the Code of Ordinances, the
11	qualifying dates set forth herein shall govern and control for the 2009 general election.
12	Section 3. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this
13	ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or
14	unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the
15	ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or
16	application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
17	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the
18	extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
19	Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption.
