

RESOLUTION NO. 160498

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE REQUEST OF A PERPETUAL EASEMENT FROM BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INTERNAL IMPROVEMENT TRUST FUND OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA TO THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

ON MOTION of Commissioner Harvey Budd, seconded by Commissioner Adrian Hayel-Santos, the following Resolution was adopted;

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation proposes to improvements to the mast arms and signal lights at the intersection of east and west sides of North South Drive, the east and west sides of Center Drive and at the entrance to Shands Teaching Hospital, in Alachua County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the base of the mast poles will be located outside of the current Florida Department of Transportation right of way and on that property owned by the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville is funding the improvements and will be the managing agent, once the project is completed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commissioners of the **CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA**, that the application by the State of Florida Department of Transportation to the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund of the State of Florida for a Perpetual Easement, is for transportation purposes which is in the public or community interest and for public welfare.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded forthwith to the State of Florida Department of Transportation at Lake City, Florida.
