I very much regret letting the Commission down this past year.

Professional Obligations:

In August of 1998 I was given the opportunity for a temporary assignment which involved attending a number of business meetings in Atlanta and Chicago and Philadelphia. The NCC meetings and business travel dates seem to constantly conflict and I missed most of the meetings during that time. My assignment was completed in July of 99, life is returning to normal, and I am again able to attend to my volunteer activities.

When NCC changed the monthly meetings to the third Thursday, it eliminated another business conflict that was causing me to miss two or three meetings a year.

Sub-Committee Chair:
