5 **An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, Chapter 9,**
6 **Elections; amending Section 9-1.1 (a) of the Code of**
7 **Ordinances changing the numbers of the election precincts**
8 **that comprise the election districts of the City; providing**
9 **directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause;**
10 **providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate**
11 **effective date.**

14 **WHEREAS**, certain properties were annexed to the City of Gainesville as of
15 September 1, 2002 as a result of an annexation referendum held on February 26, 2002;
16 and

17 **WHEREAS**, the Supervisor of Elections proposed changes to the Alachua
18 County voting precincts that were approved by the Board of County Commissioners;
19 and

20 **WHEREAS**, the above-referenced annexation and change in voting precincts
21 causes the City of Gainesville to amend the precinct numbers that comprise the three
22 election districts of the City of Gainesville; and

23 **WHEREAS**, at least 10 days notice has been given by publication in a
24 newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of
25 a Public Hearing in the Auditorium of City Hall in the City of Gainesville; and

26 **WHEREAS**, the Public Hearings were held pursuant to the published notice
27 described at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to
28 be and were, in fact, heard;

29 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE**
30 **CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:**

1 located within the corporate limits of the city.


2 **Section 2.** It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of
3 Section 1 of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of
4 Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of
5 this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.

6 **Section 3.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to
7 be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding
8 shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

9 **Section 4.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the
10 extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

11 **Section 5.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final
12 adoption.
