12	Use Element of the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan be amended, as more
13	specifically described in this ordinance; and
14	WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law and a Public
15	Hearing was then held by the City Plan Board on December 5, 2011; and
16	WHEREAS, pursuant to law, an advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10
17	inches long was placed in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this
8	proposed ordinance and of the public hearing to be held at the transmittal stage, in the City
9	Commission Auditorium, City Hall, City of Gainesville, at least seven (7) days after the day
20	the first advertisement was published; and
21	WHEREAS, pursuant to law, after the public hearing at the transmittal stage the City
22	of Gainesville transmitted copies of this proposed change to the Reviewing Agencies and any
23	other local government unit or state agency that requested same; and
24	WHEREAS, a second advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches
25	long was placed in the aforesaid newspaper notifying the public of the second public hearing
26	to be held at the adoption stage at least five (5) days after the day the second advertisement

1 described above at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to 2 be and were, in fact, heard; and 3 WHEREAS, prior to adoption of this ordinance the City Commission has considered the written comments, if any were received, concerning this plan amendment. 4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF 5 THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA: 6 Section 1. Policy 4.6.1 of the Future Land Use Element of the City of Gainesville 7 Comprehensive Plan is amended as stated below. Except as amended herein, the remainder 8 of Objective 4.6 and its Policies remain in full force and effect. 9 Policy 4.6.1 Chapter 30, City of Gainesville Code of Ordinances shall implement 10 the Future Land Use categories created by this Plan as indicated in 11 Policy 4.7.1 and shall regulate all development until superseded by 12 new land development regulations as required by this Plan. The Land 13 Development Code shall designate the zoning districts that implement 14 the Future Land Use categories created by this Plan. Proposed 15 developments that do not fall within the parameters of existing zoning 16 districts shall be permitted to develop as Planned Developments and 17 shall meet all the requirements of that zoning classification and the 18 Future Land Use Element. 19 20 21 Section 2. Objective 4.7 and Policy 4.7.1 of the Future Land Use Element of the 22 City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan are deleted in their entirety. 23 Objective 4.7 Provide the mechanism for the period after adoption of new land 24 development regulations that ensures development that is consistent 25 with the Future Land Use Map. 26 27 **Policy 4.7.1** Chapter 30. City of Gainesville Code of Ordinances shall implement 28 the Future Land Use categories created by this Plan as indicated on the 29 table labeled "Future Land Use Categories and 30

Corresponding/Implementing Zoning Districts." All development shall

be regulated by the provisions of these zoning districts.

Section 5.	The City Manager is authorized and directed to make the necessary
changes in the text,	maps and other data in the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan, or
element, or portion	thereof in order to fully implement this ordinance.

- **Section 6.** Within 10 days of the transmittal (first) hearing, the City Manager is authorized and directed to transmit a comprehensive plan amendment package, including this ordinance, to the Reviewing Agencies and to any other local government unit or state agency that has filed a written request for same with the City. Within 10 days of the adoption (second) hearing, the City Manager is authorized and directed to transmit a comprehensive plan amendment package, including this ordinance, to the State Land Planning Agency and to any other Reviewing Agency, local government unit or state agency that filed written comments with the City.
- **Section 7.** If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
- **Section 8**. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
- Section 9. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage on second reading; however, the effective date of this plan amendment, if the amendment is not timely challenged, shall be 31 days after the State Land Planning Agency notifies the City that the plan amendment package is complete in accordance with Chapter 163.3184, F.S. If timely challenged, this amendment shall become effective on the date the State Land Planning Agency
