Hello AHAC Members,

Please note that AHAC will not meet in January 2019. As we have discussed, AHAC's primary goal in 2019 is to approve a Local Housing Assistance Plan (LHAP), which basically, explains how the City will use the funds provided by the State Housing Initiative Partnership (SHIP) Program. The current LHAP is attached to this email. If you take a few moments to review the LHAP, you will see that it contains a great deal of detail about each of the Program's strategies. Over the next few months we can talk and read about each of these strategies and the rationale behind each one. We can also talk and read some about the SHIP Program on the State level, including its history and how the money is raised and spent.
