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RESOLUTION NO. 180368

A resolution of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida; relating to the levy of general municipal purpose Ad Valorem Taxes for the 2018-2019 fiscal year beginning October 1, 2018 and ending September 30, 2019; adopting the Final Millage Rate; directing the transmittal of certified copies; authorizing a specified adjustment to the final millage rate; and providing an immediate effective date.

16 **WHEREAS**, July 17, 2018, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida
17 adopted Resolution No. 180129 which approved a Proposed Tentative General Government
18 Financial and Operating Plan budget for the City of Gainesville, Florida; and

19 **WHEREAS**, on July 17, 2018, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 180130
20 approving the proposed millage rate necessary to fund the Proposed Tentative General
21 Government Financial and Operating Plan budget; and

22 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to law and utilizing the rate established in Resolution No. 180130,
23 on or about August 17, 2018, the Alachua County Property Appraiser mailed a Notice of
24 Proposed Property Taxes to each taxpayer listed on the current year's assessment roll; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the said Notice of Proposed Property Taxes advised the recipients of the
26 public hearing to be conducted by the City Commission for consideration of its Tentative
27 General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget and the Tentative Millage necessary
28 to fund the said budget; and

29 **WHEREAS**, on September 6, 2018, the City Commission held the public hearing as
30 specified in the Notice of Proposed Property Taxes and in accordance with applicable law; and

31 **WHEREAS**, on September 6, 2018, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, FL
adopted Resolution No. 180296 approving a Tentative Millage Rate necessary to fund the

1 Tentative General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget;

2 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY**
3 **OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:**

4 **Section 1.** The final operating millage rate of 4.7474 mills to fund the Final General
5 Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget for the City of Gainesville’s 2018-2019 fiscal
6 year is approved.

7 **Section 2.** The General Fund final operating millage rate approved herein is less than the
8 rolled-back rate of 4.7848 mills by 0.78%.

9 **Section 3.** The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to transmit copies of this
10 Resolution, as well as any other forms or documents required by law, to the Alachua County
11 Property Appraiser, Alachua County Tax Collector, and the Florida Dept. of Revenue within
12 three (3) days after the adoption of this Resolution.


13 **Section 4.** In the event the City is notified by the Alachua County Property Appraiser of
14 an aggregate change in the assessment roll of more than one (1) percent pursuant to Section
15 200.065(6), Florida Statutes, then the millage rate adopted in Section 1 of this Resolution may be
16 adjusted in accordance with Section 200.065(6), Florida Statutes. The City Manager is hereby
17 authorized to compute the adjustments as provided in Section 200.065(6) and administratively
18 adjust the millage rates. The City Manager is also authorized and directed to execute an official
19 notification of the millage adjustment and shall deliver the same to the Alachua County Property
20 Appraiser within three (3) days of the receipt of any notice of aggregate change in the assessment
21 roll.

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Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
