I. PURPOSE:

The purpose of this guideline is to provide a standard to be used by citizens wishing to paint the cities fire hydrants

II. RESPONSIBILITY:

It is the responsibility of all members in the Operations Division of Gainesville Fire Rescue to be familiar with this guideline, and to report any violations to The Risk Reduction Division

III. POLICY:

The Risk Reduction Division will assist any citizens with interpreting this policy if needed

IV. PROCEDURE:

Citizens of the City of Gainesville can participate in a Hydrant Beautification program if they adhere to the following guidelines.

- The barrel of the hydrant and the caps can be painted by the citizens.
- The dome of the hydrant will be painted by the department, and will be red, orange, green or blue. These colors designate the approximate water flow from the hydrant. The dome ring will also be painted by the department, and will be painted with white reflective paint.
- The barrel of the hydrant can be painted yellow, red, orange, blue or white. The caps can also be painted with

any of these colors. There can be no neon or fluorescent colors used.

- Any exceptions or neighborhood themes would have to be approved by the Fire Chief.
