30           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE**  
31 **CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:**

32           **SECTION 1.** That the City finds that participating in a resolution along the lines set forth  
33 in the Florida Plan would be in the best interest of the City and its citizens in that such a plan  
34 ensures that almost all of the settlement funds go to abate and resolve the opioid epidemic and  
35 each and every city and county receives funds for the harm that it has suffered.

36           **SECTION 2.** That the City of Gainesville hereby expresses its general support of a  
37 unified plan for the allocation and use of opioid settlement proceeds as generally described in the  
38 draft Florida Plan, attached hereto as Exhibit “A.”

39           **SECTION 3.** That upon receipt of a final version of the Florida Plan agreed to by the  
40 Defendants, City staff shall bring the final Florida Plan back to the City Commission for a final  
41 resolution.

42           **SECTION 4.** If the City Commission approves the final Florida Plan, the Mayor is  
43 hereby authorized to execute any formal agreements implementing a unified plan for the  
44 allocation and use of opioid settlement proceeds that is not substantially inconsistent with the  
45 final Florida Plan and this Resolution.

60 unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the Resolution  
61 which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to  
62 this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared severable.

63 **SECTION 7.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
