2 3 4 5 6 7	An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, to vacate, abandon and close unimproved right-of-way located in the vicinity of Block 6 of the University Place subdivision, between SW 1 <sup>st</sup> Avenue and SW 2 <sup>nd</sup> Avenue and running east for approximately 210 feet from SW 10 <sup>th</sup> Street, as more specifically described in this ordinance; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.
8	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 30-192 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of
9	Gainesville, an application was initiated by the abutting land owner to vacate, abandon and close
10	unimproved right-of-way located in the vicinity of Block 6 of the University Place subdivision,
11	between SW 1st Avenue and SW 2nd Avenue and running east for approximately 210 feet from
12	SW 10 <sup>th</sup> Street, as more specifically described herein; and
13	WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law and a public
14	hearing was held by the City Plan Board on April 24, 2014; and
15	WHEREAS, at least ten (10) days' notice has been given once by publication in a
16	newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of public
17	hearings in the City Hall Auditorium located on the first floor of City Hall in the City of
18	Gainesville; and
19	WHEREAS, prior to the public hearings the application was presented to and approved
20	by the appropriate departments of the City of Gainesville; and
21	WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that it is in the public interest to vacate, abandon
22	and close the right-of-way as set forth herein.
23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
24	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

1	Section 1. The following described right-of-way in the City of Gainesville no longer
2	serves a public purpose and is hereby vacated, abandoned and closed for use by the public
3	generally:
4 5 6 7	See legal description attached as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as if set forth in full. The location of the property is shown on Exhibit "B" for visual reference. In the event of conflict or inconsistency, Exhibit "A" shall prevail over Exhibit "B."
8	Section 2. The City reserves unto itself, its successors and assigns a public and private
9	utilities easement over, under, across and through the right-of-way described in Section 1 of this
10	ordinance for the purpose of installing, maintaining and operating public and private utilities.
11	<b>Section 3.</b> The Clerk of the Commission or designee is authorized to record a true copy
12	of this ordinance in the public records of Alachua County, Florida.
13	Section 4. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance
14	or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such
15	finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance that can be given
16	effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application, and to this end the
17	provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
18	Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of
19	such conflict hereby repealed.
20	<b>Section 6.</b> This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

## **Legal Description**

A portion of Section 5, Township10 South, Range 20 East, City of Gainesville, Alachua County, Florida; being more particularly described as follows:

That certain 15' wide alley lying south of Lots 6-9 and north of Lots 10-13 in Block 6 of a subdivision known as "University Place", according to the plat thereof recorded in Plat Book "A", Page 77 of the public records of Alachua County, Florida.
