1	ORDINANCE NO. <u>100690</u>
2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9	An Ordinance amending the City of Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use Element; amending the Intergovernmental Coordination Element by repealing the obsolete Innovation Zone Map and adopting the new Innovation Zone Map and adding it to the Future Land Use Map Series; amending Objective 1.7 of the Intergovernmental Coordination Element to reference the Innovation Zone Map in the Future Land Use Map Series; providing directions to the City Manager and the codifier; providing a severability clause; and providing an effective date.
12	WHEREAS, publication of notice of a public hearing was given that the Future Land
13	Use and Intergovernmental Coordination Elements of the City of Gainesville 2000-2010
14	Comprehensive Plan be amended, as more specifically described in this ordinance; and
15	WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law and a public
16	hearing was held by the City Plan Board on January 27, 2011; and
17	WHEREAS, pursuant to law, an advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10
18	inches long was placed in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this
19	proposed ordinance and of the Public Hearing to be held in the City Commission Meeting Room,
20	First Floor, City Hall, in the City of Gainesville at least seven (7) days after the day the first
21	advertisement was published; and
22	WHEREAS, pursuant to law, after the public hearing at the transmittal stage, the City of
23	Gainesville transmitted copies of this proposed change to the State Land Planning Agency; and
24	WHEREAS, a second advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches long
25	was placed in the aforesaid newspaper notifying the public of the second Public Hearing to be
26	held at the adoption stage at least five (5) days after the day the second advertisement was

published; and

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1	WHEREAS, public hearings were held pursuant to the published notices described		
2	above at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were,		
3	in fact, heard; and		
4	WHEREAS, prior to adoption of this ordinance, the City Commission has considered the		
5	comments, recommendations and objections, if any, of the State Land Planning Agency.		
6	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE		
7	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:		
8	Section 1. The Intergovernmental Coordination Element of the City of Gainesville 2000-		
9	2010 Comprehensive Plan is amended by repealing the Innovation Zone Map as codified in the		
10	Intergovernmental Coordination Element.		
11	Section 2. The Future Land Use Map Series of the City of Gainesville 2000-2010		
12	Comprehensive Plan is amended by adopting the new Innovation Zone Map, and adding the		
13	Innovation Zone Map to the Future Land Use Map Series, attached as Exhibit "A" and made a		
14	part hereof as if set forth in full.		
15	Section 3. Objective 1.7 of the Intergovernmental Coordination Element of the City of		
16	Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive Plan is amended as follows (the Policies of Objective 1.7		
17	are not changed):		
18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27	The City shall work with community partners such as the University of Florida, Santa Fe Community College, the Gainesville Area Chamber of Commerce, Alachua County, and the Alachua County School Board to help develop the Innovative Economy within the non-residential areas of the Gainesville Innovation Zone (Note: The Innovation Zone Map is part of the Future Land Use Map Series). For purposes of this objective, Innovative Economy means those technology firms and/or entities that bring a new process or technique to the production process and that are often, but not exclusively, related in some manner to University driven research, and are generally represented by sectors such as Agritechnology, Aviation and Aerospace, Information Technology, Life Sciences and Medical Technology.		

1	Section 4. The City Manager is authorized and directed to make the necessary changes
2	in the text, maps and other data in the City of Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive Plan, or
3	element, or portion thereof in order to fully implement this ordinance.
4	Section 5. It is the intent of the City Commission that the provisions of Sections 1

through 3 shall become and be made a part of the City of Gainesville 2000-2010 Comprehensive Plan and that the sections and paragraphs of this ordinance may be renumbered in order to accomplish such intentions.

Section 6. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

Section 7. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage on second reading; however, the effective date of this plan amendment, if the amendment is not timely challenged, shall be 31 days after the state land planning agency notifies the City that the plan amendment package is complete in accordance with Chapter 163.3184, F.S. If timely challenged, this amendment shall become effective on the date the state land planning agency or the Administration Commission enters a final order determining this adopted amendment to be in compliance in accordance with Chapter 163.3184, F.S. No development orders, development

1	permits, or land uses dependent on this amendment may be issued or commenced before this				
2	plan amendment has become effective.
