The rolled-back millage rate for the general municipal purpose, as computed 25 pursuant to Section 200.065 (1), Florida Statutes, is 4.4877 mills. 26 Section 2. The proposed millage rate necessary to fund the proposed tentative 27 general purpose municipal budget for the City of Gainesville's 2005-2006 fiscal year is 4.9416 28 mills. 29

1	Section 3. A public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the
2	proposed tentative budget for general municipal purposes on Monday, September 12, 2005, at six
3	o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the City Hall Auditorium on the
4	first floor of City Hall, 200 East University Avenue, City of Gainesville, Florida.
5	Section 4. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to provide a copy of this
6	resolution to the Alachua County Property Appraiser for use in preparing the Notice of Proposed
7	Property Taxes, as required by Section 200.069, Florida Statutes, and to execute, as the
8	Administering Official, any Department of Revenue forms necessary to complete this
9	certification.
10	Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
