Call for Nominations

Each year, the Florida Trust for Historic Preservation recognizes significant contributions to the preservation of Florida's historic resources through its Annual Awards Program. The Florida Trust invites you to participate this year by submitting nominations for outstanding historic preservation projects, programs and achievements by individuals and organizations. The Florida Trust will applaud recipient accomplishments at the prestigious Annual Preservation Awards Program held May 22, 1999 during the 1999 Annual Meeting in Gainesville. Thank you for your continued support of the Florida Trust's Annual Preservation Awards Program.

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NOMINATION PROCEDURES

All nominations must be submitted on the nomination form provided (or photocopied form) with the attachments as described in this brochure. To be eligible, projects, programs and achievements by individuals must have been completed between January 1996 and January 1999. The Awards Jury reserves the right to disqualify any nomination that is incomplete or does not meet the nomination requirements.

The Awards Jury will evaluate the nominations based on the Secretary of the Interior's Standards; the quality, significance and uniqueness of the project. For organizations and individuals, the evaluation will be based on the impact the nominee has had on the community and the degree to which the person or group furthers preservation goals.

The Awards Jury will notify recipients during the month of April with the official presentation on May 22, 1999 during the Florida Trusts Annual Meeting in Gainesville. Please submit the specific information relevant to your category(s) of nomination.

RESTORATION/REHABILITATION
Make duplicate copies of all nomination materials (including slides, videos, publications) as all materials sent become the property of the Florida Trust and will not be returned to the applicants.

Restoration of a structure to an earlier or original appearance; or rehabilitation for adaptive new use; or a new construction within a historic context of single family, multifamily, office or commercial structures.

HISTORIC LANDSCAPE/ARCHAEOLOGY
Restoration of a historic landscape or the preservation of an archaeological project.

- Two page statement describing why the nomination deserves an award (10 copies).

- Map locating the project (10 copies).
- Twenty 35mm slides illustrating the historic, before and after conditions of the project. All slides must be in a horizontal format and numbered with an attached reference page describing each slide.

PRESERVATION EDUCATION/MEDIA
Recognizes outstanding heritage education program i.e., books, brochures, curriculum, videos or other publications on historic preservation.

- One copy of the publication, film, video or other document. Film and video must be submitted in 1/2" VHS format.

ORGANIZATION ACHIEVEMENT

Recognizes outstanding achievement in preservation activities by a group, business, neighborhood or other organization.

- Two page statement describing why the nomination deserves an award (10 copies).

- Twenty 35mm slides illustrating the work for which the organization or individual is being nominated. All slides must be in a horizontal format and numbered with an attached reference page describing each slide.
- Letters of support (10 copies).

INDIVIDUAL DISTINGUISHED SERVICE
Recognizes outstanding contributions to preservation by an individual in Florida.

- Completed nomination form (10 copies).
- Two page statement describing why the nominee deserves an award (10 copies).

- Twenty 35mm slides illustrating the work for which the organization or individual is being nominated. All slides must be in a horizontal format and numbered with an attached reference page describing each slide.
- Letters of support (10 copies).
- Nominee resume (10 copies).
- Application Fee.

Please submit the specific information relevant to your category(s) of nomination. If the nomination application package is not complete (i.e. missing appropriate number of slides and copies) it will be immediately disqualified.

Slides will be used to create the final video presentation that will be shown at the 20th Annual Preservation Awards Ceremony on May 22, 1999, in Gainesville.

Make duplicate copies of all nomination materials (including slides) as all materials become the property of the Florida Trust and will not be returned to the applicant.
