RESOLUTION NO. 050446

PASSED September 26, 2005

A resolution of the City of Gainesville, Florida, adopting "The National Incident Management System (NIMS)" as the basis for all Incident Management in the City of Gainesville; providing authorization to the City Manager; and providing an immediate effective date.

WHEREAS, the President in Homeland Security Directive (HSPD)-5, directed the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security to develop and administer a National Incident Management System which would provide a consistent nationwide approach for Federal, State, local, and tribal governments to work together more effectively and efficiently to prepare for, prevent, respond to, and recover from domestic incidents, regardless of cause, size, or complexity; and,

WHEREAS, the collective input and guidance from all Federal, State, local, and tribal homeland security partners has been, and will continue to be, vital to the effective implementation and utilization of a comprehensive NIMS; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable that all Federal, State, local, and tribal emergency agencies and personnel coordinate their efforts to effectively and efficiently provide the highest levels of incident management; and,

WHEREAS, HSPD-5 requires Federal departments and agencies to make adoption of the NIMS by State, tribal, and local organizations a condition for Federal preparedness assistance beginning in fiscal year 2005; and,

WHEREAS, to facilitate the most efficient and effective incident management it is critical that Federal, State, local, and tribal organizations utilize standardized terminology, standardized organizational structures, interoperable communications, consolidated action plans, unified

1	command structures, uniform personnel qualification standards, uniform standards for planning,
2	training, and exercising, comprehensive resource management, and designated incident
3	facilities during emergencies or disasters; and,
4	WHEREAS, the NIMS standardized procedures for managing personnel,
4	WHEREAS, the Minds standardized procedures for managing personner,
5	communications, facilities and resources will improve the State's ability to utilize federal funding
6	to enhance local and state agency readiness, maintain first responder safety, and streamline
7	incident management processes; and,
8	WHEREAS, the Incident Command System components of NIMS are already an integral
9	part of various incident management activities throughout the State, including current
10	emergency management training programs; and
11	WHEREAS, the National Commission on Terrorist Attacks (9-11 Commission)
12	recommended adoption of a standardized Incident Command System;
13	
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
15	OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
16	Section 1. The City of Gainesville hereby establishes the National Incident
17	Management System (NIMS) as the city standard for incident management.
18	Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to incorporate the National Incident

Management System (NIMS) into all city-wide Emergency Operations Plans for management of

emergencies.

1	Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
