15	general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of public hearings to be			
16	held in the City Commission Auditorium, City Hall, City of Gainesville; and			
17	WHEREAS, the Public Hearings were held pursuant to the published notice described at which			
18	hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact heard.			
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE,

21	Section 1. Section 2-262 of Chapter 2, Article V, Division 2 of the City of Gainesville Code of			
22	Ordinances is amended to read as follows.			
23	Sec. 2-262 Membership.			
24 25 26 27	(a) The city beautification board shall consist of <u>15</u> <u>nine</u> members. The members shall be appointed by the city commission, one of whom shall be annually elected chair by the board. Each member shall be appointed for a term of three years that shall begin on the first day of November of the year the member is appointed, except that four of the members appointed in 1996 shall be appointed for an 11-month term to begin on			

29 30		December 1, 1996 and end on October 31, 1997. A board member may not serve on the board for more than two consecutive three-year terms.		
31 32	(b)	Vacancies on said board shall be filled by the city commission for the unexpired term of the member whose vacancy is being filled.		
33	(c)	All members of the board shall be residents of the county.

35	Section 2. Section 2-264 of Chapter 2, Article V, Division 2 of the City of Gainesville Code of			
36	Ordinances is amended to read as follows.			
37	Sec. 2-264 Function and duties.			
38 39 40 41 42	The city beautification board shall study, investigate, develop, assist, advise and recommend to the city commission any and all matters pertaining to beautification, sanitation, environment and citizens' participation relating to same. In carrying out its function and duties, the board shall advise and recommend plans to organizations and groups in the city and promote public interest in the general improvement of the appearance of the city.			
43 44	Section 3. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Sections 1 and 2 of			
45	this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of			
46	Gainesville, Florida, and that the sections and paragraphs of this ordinance may be renumbered			
47	or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.			
48	Section 4. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or the			
49	application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such			
50	finding shall not affect the other provisions or application of the ordinance which can be given			
51	effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the			
52	provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.			
53	Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of such			
54	confli	ct hereby repealed.		

55	<b>Section 6.</b> This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption.
