An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending Chapter 25, Article V, Section 25-81 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, relating to the communications services tax rate; by adjusting the rate of the local communications service tax for specific time periods as more specifically provided in this ordinance; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an effective date.

Recommendation: The City Commission adopt the proposed ordinance.

At its meeting of July 8, 2002, the City Commission authorized the City Attorney to draft and the Clerk of the Commission to advertise an ordinance amending the communications services tax rate for specific time periods. The ordinance becomes effective on October 1, 2002.

4	of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a Public Hearing in
5	the City Commission Auditorium in City Hall, City of Gainesville; and
16	WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held pursuant to the published notice described at
17	which hearing the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact,
18	heard;
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
20	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
21	Section 1. Section 25-81 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville is hereby
22	amended to read as follows:
23	Sec. 25-81. Local communications services tax.
24	Effective with respect to communications services reflected on bills dated on or after
25	October 1, 2001, there is imposed and levied by the city a local communications services tax,
26	administered in accordance with F.S. Ch. 202. The city hereby imposes the following rate
27	structure in accordance with Chapter 202 and Alachua County's local option sales tax:
28	(a) For taxable sales of communications services on bills dated October 1, 20012
29	through December October 31, 20012, the local communications services tax rate shall be 5.42

1	5.62 percent, which percentage includes 0.6 percent allocated to Alachua County's local option
2	sales tax in accordance with F.S. §202.20(3).
3	(b) For taxable sales of communications services on bills dated January 1, 2002
4	through September 30, 2002, November 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, the local
5	communications services tax rate shall be 6.02 6.22 percent, which percentage includes 0.6
6	percent allocated to Alachua County's local option sales tax in accordance with F.S. §202.20(3).
7	(c) For taxable sales of communications services on bills dated October 1, 2002
8	through December 31, 2002 January 1, 2003 through October 31, 2003, the local
9	communications services tax rate shall be 5.62 percent, which percentage includes 0.6 percent
10	allocated to Alachua County's local option sales tax in accordance with F.S. §202.20(3).
11	(d) Effective for For taxable sales of communications services on bills dated on or
12	after January 1, 2003 November 1, 2003, the local communications services tax rate shall be 5.02
13.	<u>5.32</u> percent.
14	
15	Section 2. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of this
16	Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville
17	Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered
18	in order to accomplish such intentions.
19	
20	Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or
21	unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect
22	the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

1 Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of such 2 conflict hereby repealed. 3 4 Section 5.
