ORDINANCE NO.

#### 0-08-47

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, repealing Section 2-248, relating to student adjunct members; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.

#### WHEREAS, the City Commission, in order to make the appointment of student

- 11 adjuncts more efficient and flexible, will make student adjunct appointments in a more
- 12 informal manner under the supervision of the Clerk of the Commission; and
- 13 WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper

14 of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of public hearings to be

15 held in the City Commission Auditorium, City Hall, City of Gainesville; and

16 WHEREAS, the Public Hearings were held pursuant to the published notice described at

17 which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact,

18 heard.

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#### 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE

- 20 CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
- Section 1. Section 2-248 is repealed from the Code of Ordinances, City of Gainesville,
  as follows:

### 23 Sec. 2-248. Appointment of student adjunct members.

24 (a) The city commission will appoint one student in an adjunct member status during the fall

25 term of the academic year to each of the standing advisory boards, commissions, and committees

- 26 of the city which shall be in addition to the members already designated, except the city Plan
- 27 Board, the Board of Trustees of the Consolidated Police Officers' and Firefighters' Retirement
- 28 Plan, the Code Enforcement Board, the Community Redevelopment Agency, the Gainesville-

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1	Alachua County Regional Airport Authority, and the Gainesville Housing Authority. In making
2	these appointments, the city commission shall consider the recommendations of the board,
3	commission or committee; the University of Florida student government; the University of
4	Florida College Council and the Santa Fe Community College student government. However,
5	appointments are not limited to University of Florida or Santa Fe Community College students.
6	(b) In order to apply for appointment to a board, commission or committee, a student must
7	attend at least either the August or September meeting of that board, commission or committee.
8	The board, commission or committee will conduct an interview of the student to discuss the
9	function of, and the student's interest in, the board, commission or committee. The board,
10	commission or committee shall, after interviewing all potential student adjunct members, submit
11	a recommendation for appointment to the Clerk of the Commission by 5 p.m. on the first
12	Monday of October. A student may apply for appointment to one or two boards, commissions or
13	committees during an academic year. Any student who applies for appointment to more than two
14	boards, commissions or committees will not be considered for any appointment.
15	(c) Each student appointee will attend meetings, listening and participating in discussions in the
16	same manner as if the student were a member of the advisory board, commission or committee,
17	however the student will not count towards a quorum. The student adjunct members do not have
18	the power to cast votes on any quasi judicial matters.
19	(d) The term to be held by the student adjunct member will begin upon appointment and
20	continue until the end of the summer term of that academic year. If a student adjunct member
21	resigns or the position otherwise becomes vacant before the spring term of the academic year, the
22	city commission will appoint a replacement at the beginning of the spring term to serve until the
23	end of the summer term. If a student adjunct member resigns or the position otherwise becomes

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1	vacant after the beginning of the spring term of academic year, the position will remain vacant
2	until the beginning of the fall term of the next academic year.
3	Section 2. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 be
4	deleted from the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida.
5	Section 3. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance
6	or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such
7	finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given
8	effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the
9	provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
10	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of
11	such conflict hereby repealed.
12	Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
