Discuss the Search General Manager-Utilities (B)

Explanation: At its February 20, 2014 City Commission Meeting, the City Commission directed staff to schedule a GRU Manager Search workshop in May/June.

Fiscal Note: The anticipated fiscal impact of a search and selection of GM-Utilities is \$70,000. This amount includes \$55,000 in search fees and \$15,000 allocated for candidate travel and other expenses.

The proposed FY15 budget will include sufficient funds to pay for the GM Search.

Based on salary survey data collected and presented to the City Commission in January 2014, GRU's FY15 proposed budget will include funds necessary to provide a total annual salary of \$291,091 for GRU's General Manager.

RECOMMENDATION

The City Commission discuss plans to fill the General Manager -Utilities position. The Human Resources Department will present a recommendation regarding an Executive Search at a future City Commission Meeting based on the discussion.
