AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A, SECTION UTILITIES (3) WATER OF THE GAINESVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY INCREASING CERTAIN WATER INSPECTION SERVICE FEES, METER INSTALLATION CHARGES, CUSTOMER SERVICE CHARGES, BASE RATES FOR SERVICE, AND WATER TRANSMISSION, DISTRIBUTION AND PLANT CONNECTION CHARGES AND INSPECTION FEES; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING DIRECTIONS TO THE CODIFIER; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHEDULE PROVIDED HEREIN.

WHEREAS, at least ten (10) days notice has been given of the public hearings once by publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of the public hearings in the City Commission meeting room, first floor, City Hall, City of Gainesville; and

WHEREAS, the public hearings were held pursuant to the published notices described above at which hearings the parties with interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

- (ii) There will be a minimum charge of ~~\$2,021~~ \$4,521 for meters larger than 2 inches.

Section 2. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.

Section 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

Section 4. If any portion of this ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.


