Commissioners,

The Chairman and I have discussed the subjects for the next Tuesday's special meeting on September 20th. We will begin at 10:00 am and are requesting preliminary presentations by the City of Newberry regarding their fairgrounds "alternative" project and City of Alachua regarding their facilities expansion project. This will involve discussion of TDC funding and/ or potentially the General Fund and processes required to allocate funding.

The afternoon session will deal with a potential 2012 referendum for optional sales tax(es) for road capital infrastructure and/or transit sales tax alternatives. This will also be a preliminary discussion of both infrastructure sales surtax and transit surtax and their abilities to best fund future road capital infrastructure and transit plans.

Design agenda accordingly and confirm with Suzanne Gable opportunity for any issues that arises prior to budget hearings.

Groups advocating or concerned with these projects and activities are encouraged to present them at this preliminary discussion of these major budgetary issues.
