5	become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and
6	Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered or re-lettered in order to accomplish such intentions.
7	Section 4. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or the application
8	hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other
9	provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional
10	provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
11	Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption; provided however, the rates
12	and charges as provided for herein shall be applicable to all monthly bills which are for the first time rendered and
13	postmarked after 12:01 A.M., October 1, 2009.
