# Post-FSAA Deployment Changes

Item # 180067

- Quint 9 fully-staffed with four firefighters 24/7
- Squad 9 fully-staffed with three firefighters 9 am – 9 pm\*
- District 3 staffed 7 am – 6 pm Mon-Thu\*
- Engine 10 equipped for reserve activation

\*Evaluating data to determine peak time and day of week deployment options.

<b>Quint - 9</b>	<b>27*</b>	<b>6%</b>
<b>Squad - 9</b>	<b>20*</b>	<b>5%</b>
Engine - 2	39	9%
Tower - 2	13	3%
Engine - 4	39	9%
<b>Total</b>	<b>138</b>	<b>32%</b>

\*Demand in SW: 17% of the Responses occurred simultaneously

# Preliminary Post-FSAA Performance

90<sup>th</sup> Percentile Performance improved an avg of 7% across these measures:

Measure	Percent Improved
Travel to Bldg Fires	5.0%
Travel to EMS	5.7%
Travel to Fire	5.9%
Travel to Fire (non-ems)	7.6%
Travel to Priority EMS	10.0%
Turn-out Time (Avg)	10.4%
