4 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA, AMENDING
5 APPENDIX A, SECTION UTILITIES (1) ELECTRICITY SUBSECTION i1(C)(vii).
6 OF THE GAINESVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING THE RATE
7 SCHEDULE FOR SOLAR ENERGY PURCHASE AGREEMENTS OF THE FEED-
8 IN TARIFF; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING DIRECTIONS TO
9 THE CODIFIER; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND, PROVIDING AN
10 IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHEDULE
11 PROVIDED HEREIN.

13 WHEREAS, at least ten (10) days notice has been given of the public hearings once by
14 publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance
15 and of the public hearings in the City Commission meeting room, first floor, City Hall, City of
16 Gainesville; and

17 WHEREAS, the public hearings were held pursuant to the published notices described
18 above, at which all interested parties had an opportunity to be, and were, in fact, heard.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
20 OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

21 Section 1. Appendix A, Section Utilities (1) Electricity subsection i1(C)(vii). Distributed
22 Resources Rates of the Gainesville Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

23 UTILITIES

24 (1) Electricity

25 i. Distributed Resources Rates (§ 27-27):

26 1. General Provision.

27 (C). Solar Energy Purchase Agreement (SEPA)/FIT: This rate shall be applicable
28 to all classes of electric customers and non-customers located within the
29 utility electric distribution service area.

30 (vii) The solar FIT class determination is defined here within and the rate is
31 established in accordance with the following schedule which is subject
32 to periodic review and subsequent revision to the rates as
33 recommended by the general manager, or his/her designee, and

Class 1: Building or pavement-mounted systems less than or equal to 10 kW DC or freestanding ground-mounted systems (non-building or non-pavement-mounted) less than or equal to 10 kW DC.
Class 2: Building or pavement-mounted systems greater than 10 kW DC and less than or equal to 300 kW DC, or freestanding ground-mounted systems (non-building or non-pavement-mounted) greater than 10 kW DC and less than or equal to 25 kW DC
Class 3: Freestanding ground-mounted systems (non-building or non-pavement-mounted) greater than 25 kW DC.


