14	WHEREAS, the clerk of the commission has recommended a date of April 2, 2002; and	
15	WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper of	
16	general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a Public	
17	Hearing in the Auditorium of City Hall in the City of Gainesville; and	
18	WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held pursuant to the published notice described at	
19	which hearing the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in	
20	fact, heard;	
21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE	
22	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:	
23	Section 1. The 2002 regular election for the City of Gainesville shall be held on April 2,	
24	2002; and, pursuant to section 9-2 of the Code of Ordinances, the date of the run-off	
25	election, if necessary, shall be April 16, 2002.	
26	Section 2. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid	
27	or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no	

1	way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.		
2	Section 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of		
3	such conflict hereby repealed.		
4	Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption.
