A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA; RELATING TO THE LEVY OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSE AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE 2000-2001 FISCAL YEAR; ESTABLISHING PROPOSED MILLAGE RATES; SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING; PROVIDING FOR NOTICE TO THE ALACHUA COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER; PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Alachua County Property Appraiser certified the 2000 taxable values to the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida on June 19, 2000,

WHEREAS, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, requires the City Commission to advise the Property Appraiser of its rolled-back millage rate, its proposed millage rate, and of the time, date, and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the proposed tentative budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

1. The rolled-back millage rate for general municipal purposes, as computed pursuant to Section 200.065(1), Florida Statutes, is 4.7647 mills.

2. The proposed millage rate necessary to fund the proposed tentative general purpose municipal budget for the City of Gainesville's 2000-2001 fiscal year is 4.9416 mills.

3. A public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the proposed tentative budget for general municipal purposes on September 11, 2000, at six o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as it may be heard, in the City Hall Auditorium on the first floor of City Hall, 200 East University Avenue, City of Gainesville, Florida.

4. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to provide a copy of this resolution to the Alachua County Property Appraiser for use in preparing the Notice of Proposed Property Taxes, as required by Section 200.069, Florida Statutes, and to execute, as the Administering Official, any Department of Revenue forms necessary to complete this certification.


5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
