10 11	WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once prior to adoption by publication		
12	in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a		
13	Public Hearing in the City Commission Auditorium in City Hall, City of Gainesville; and		
14	WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held pursuant to the published notice described at		
15	which hearing the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact,		
16	heard;		
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE		
18	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA.		
19	Section 1. Section 14.5-27 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville is		
20	amended to read as follows:		
21	Sec. 14.5-27. Authorized Ffees charged and charges.		
22	a) Any towing firm engaged in the business of trespass towing shall not charge the owner of		
23	any towed vehicle or personal property in excess of \$73.00 for the removal of a vehicle. the fee		
24	set by the City Commission by Resolution. The fee of \$73.00 set by Resolution shall be all		
25	inclusive; during the first 24 hour period following notification of vehicle tow to the Gainesville		
26	Police Department; and no additional fees or charges whatsoever may be charged for using		
27	dollies, trailers, lifts, slim jims, or any other special equipment or services; unless specifically		
28	established and authorized herein or by state statute. However, the maximum fees in this		

- section shall not apply to trespass towing of vehicles which have more than two axles or more
- than four road wheels or are rated to carry more than one ton.
- 3 b) Maximum trespass towing fees shall be established no more than annually by the city
- 4 commission after receiving a request for fee modification by the towing company owners and
- staff recommendations based on financial information submitted by the trespass towing
- 6 companies as to their costs for the removal of vehicles and on other information. The required
- 7 information shall be submitted by the towing company owners by September 30 of each year.
- 8 The maximum fees shall be set by resolution to be adopted by the city commission prior to
- 9 December 31 of each year in which a request for modification has been made. Such maximum
- fees shall be effective during the following calendar year and until changed by subsequent
- 11 resolution.
- Section 2. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of
- this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of
- Gainesville, Florida, and that the sections and paragraphs of this ordinance may be re-numbered
- or re-lettered in order to accomplish such intentions.
- Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be
- invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no
- way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
- Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of
- such conflict hereby repealed.
- Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective on January 1, 2004.
