

1 **WHEREAS**, on September 8, 2010, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville,
2 Florida, adopted Resolution No. 100325 approving a proposed millage rate necessary to fund the
3 Amended Tentative General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget;

5 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE**
6 **CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:**

7 **Section 1.** The final operating millage rate of 4.2544 mills to fund the Final General
8 Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget for the City of Gainesville’s 2010-2011 fiscal
9 year is approved.

10 **Section 2.** The General Fund operating millage rate approved herein is less than the
11 rolled-back rate of 4.7002 by 0.4458 mill, which results in a 9.48% decrease in property taxes.

12 **Section 3.** The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to transmit copies of this
13 Resolution, as well as any other forms or documents required by law, to the Alachua County
14 Property Appraiser and the Alachua County Tax Collector within three (3) days after the
15 adoption of this Resolution.

16 **Section 4.** In the event the City is notified by the Alachua County Property Appraiser of
17 an aggregate change in the assessment roll of more than one (1) percent pursuant to Section
18 200.065(6), Florida Statutes, then the millage rate adopted in Section 1 of this Resolution may be
19 adjusted in accordance with Section 200.065(6), Florida Statutes. The City Manager is hereby
20 authorized to compute the adjustments as provided in Section 200.065(6) and administratively
21 adjust the millage rates. The City Manager is also authorized and directed to execute an official
22 notification of the millage adjustment and shall deliver the same to the Alachua County Property
23 Appraiser within three (3) days of the receipt of any notice of aggregate change in the assessment
24 roll.

1 **Section 5.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
