#### **COMPLAINT**

Plaintiffs, JOSE RODOLFO RAMIREZ and LUISANA RAMIREZ, his wife, sue Defendant, CITY OF GAINESVILLE d/b/a GAINESVILLE REGIONAL UTILITIES, and allege:

- 1. This is an action for damages that exceeds Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00), exclusive of interest, costs and attorneys' fees.
  - 2. Plaintiffs are husband and wife and reside together in Hidalgo County, Texas.
- 3. At all times material to this action, CITY OF GAINESVILLE d/b/a GAINESVILLE REGIONAL UTILITIES is subject to jurisdiction in Florida in that it was operating, conducting, engaging in or carrying on a business or business venture in this state, committed a tortious act within this state. Additionally, CITY OF GAINESVILLE d/b/a GAINESVILLE REGIONAL UTILITIES is a municipality located in Alachua County, Florida.

- 4. On or about November 16, 2006, Plaintiff, JOSE RAMIREZ, was a supervisor for A & J Electric which was constructing a hotel in Gainesville by the name of Spring Hill Suites, located at 4155 SW 40<sup>th</sup> Boulevard, Gainesville, Florida. At that time and place, he was using a backhoe to dig and struck an unmarked high pressure gas line causing the line to rupture and a gas explosion.
- 5. At that time and place, Plaintiff was lawfully upon the premises and Defendant owed Plaintiff a duty to as it is responsible for marking existing utility service lines and high-pressure gas lines. Defendant failed to clearly designate where the gas line was which created a hidden hazard to Plaintiff, thus creating an unreasonably dangerous condition to Plaintiff.
- 6. At that time and place, Defendant breached its duty owed to Plaintiff by committing one or more of the following negligent acts of omission or commission:
  - a) Negligently failing to inspect or adequately inspect said gas line, thus creating an unreasonably dangerous condition;
  - b) Negligently failing to warn or adequately warn Plaintiff of the danger of said buried gas line and lack of clear designation of where said gas line was, when Defendant knew or through the exercise of reasonable care should have known that said gas line was unreasonably dangerous and that Plaintiff was unaware of same; and
  - c) Negligently failing to correct or adequately correct the unreasonably dangerous condition when said condition was either known to Defendant or had existed for a sufficient length of time such that Defendant should have known of same had it exercised reasonable care.

- 7. At that time and place, as a result, while Plaintiff was digging in said area, he struck the unmarked high pressure gas line, sustaining severe injuries as set forth below.
- 8. As a direct and proximate result of the negligence of Defendant, Plaintiff suffered bodily injury in and about his body and extremities, resulting in pain and suffering, disability, disfigurement, permanent and significant scarring, mental anguish, loss of the capacity for the enjoyment of life, expense of hospitalization, medical and nursing care and treatment, loss of earning, loss of the ability to earn money, and aggravation of previously existing condition. The losses are either permanent or continuing and Plaintiff will suffer the losses in the future.

WHEREFORE, the Plaintiff, JOSE RAMIREZ, sues the Defendants, CITY OF GAINESVILLE d/b/a GAINESVILLE REGIONAL UTILITIES, for damages and demands judgment in excess of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00), plus interest and costs, and demands trial by jury of all issues so triable.

### CONSORTIUM CLAIM OF LUISANA RAMIREZ AGAINST CITY OF GAINESVILLE D/B/A GAINESVILLE REGIONAL UTILITIES

Plaintiff, LUISANA RAMIREZ, realleges and incorporates by reference paragraphs 1 through 8, and further states:

9. As a direct and proximate result of the negligence of Defendant and the resulting injuries to the spouse, Plaintiff, LUISANA RAMIREZ, was caused to suffer an impairment of the services, companionship and consortium of the spouse and will suffer such losses in the future.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff, LUISANA RAMIREZ, demands judgment for damages against Defendant, CITY OF GAINESVILLE d/b/a GAINESVILLE REGIONAL UTILITIES, and other

such relief deemed proper by the Court. Plaintiffs also demand a jury trial on all issues so triable.
