



28           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE**  
29 **CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:**

30           **Section 1.** Portions of Appendix A of the Code of Ordinances, relating to fees are amended  
31 as set forth below. Except as amended herein, the remainder of Appendix A remains in full force  
32 and effect.

- 46           a. Zones 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, and 12..... \$61.00
  - 47           b. Zones 1, 2, 5, and 10..... \$121.50
- 48           (6) Service permit..... ~~\$25.00~~ 145.00
- 49           (7) Fee to appeal revocation..... \$163.00
- 50           (8) Fee for reinstatement after revocation..... \$163.00

52           **Section 2.** It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1  
53 shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida,  
54 and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in order  
55 to accomplish such intentions.

56           **Section 3.** If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance  
57 or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such  
58 finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given  
59 effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the  
60 provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

61           **Section 4.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of  
62 such conflict hereby repealed on the effective date of this ordinance.

63           **Section 5.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
