A Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, authorizing the Interim City Manager to execute a Public Transportation Grant Agreement between the City of Gainesville and the Florida Department of Transportation to receive State Public Transit Block Grant Program funds for transit operating assistance for FY22.

WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville owns and operates the public transit system serving the Gainesville urbanized area in Alachua County; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation makes available State Public Transit Block Grant Funds for transit operating assistance every year; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation requires the execution of a Public Transportation Grant Agreement by the City and the provision of matching funds,

 ${\bf NOW, THEREFORE}, {\tt BE}$ IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

- 1. That the Interim City Manager or her designee is authorized to execute a Public Transportation Grant Agreement between the City of Gainesville and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to accept the allocation of State Public Transit Block Grant funding for the City of Gainesville Regional Transit System (RTS).
- 2. That the Interim City Manager or her authorized designee is authorized to execute the Public Transportation Grant Agreement (PTGA) including any supplemental agreements for the purpose of Scope Changes and/or funding adjustments, as well as execute Assurances, Certifications, and all other documents as may be required in support of the project.
- 3. That the Interim City Manager or her authorized designee is authorized to sign requests for Contract Time Extension(s), as may be required in support of the project.
- 4. That the Interim City Manager, within the City's approved budget, is authorized to provide the local share to match such grant funds as may be required.
- 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
