#### **Background – CRA Office Relocation**

- At November 17, 2008 CRA, Board approved the following recommendation:
  - "Approve 802 NW Ave as site of new CRA mixed-used office building, contingent on the resolution of parking availability at the adjacent City-owned lot"





#### **Project Accomplishments since November CRA Meeting**


- Met with Public Works and Legal to discuss and resolve parking issue
  - Parking lot was acquired through eminent domain in 1976
  - No restrictions exist that would disallow use by the CRA and patrons of building
- Completed RFQ selection process for Architects for Minor Projects (less than \$1M in construction or \$50k for studies)
  - Qualified 3 firms (DAG, Urban Studios, and 4M Design)
  - Signed 3-year contracts
- Selected DAG Architects to provide architectural and engineering services for CRA Office Building Project
- Completed 1<sup>st</sup> Step Meeting
- Conducted internal project kick-off and visioning session with DAG
- Determined that on-site stormwater management will be required
- Determined that a Minor Traffic Study will not be needed
- Determined that the 15 foot wide "hiatus" immediately north of the project site is zoned MU-1
- Completed preliminary Field Review of the NW 4th Avenue Building Structures for Potential Reuse and Suitability for Satisfying LEED Requirements
- Completed initial project schedule and timeline

#### **Upcoming Milestones (before next CRA meeting)**

- Week of March 2, 2009 Issue RFQ for Construction Managers for Minor Projects
  - To qualify 2-3 construction management firms for 3-year contracts for construction projects less than \$1M
  - Will select one of these firms to develop a proposal and build the CRA Office Building
  - Process expected to take about three (3) months
- March 3, 2009 Neighborhood Meeting 6 pm at Wilhelmina Johnson Center
- March 11, 2009 Site Development Plan Package Due
  - Submission will include Site Engineering Plan, Landscape Plan, Boundary and Topographic Survey to meet the City's requirements and only a basic building floor plan with the four (4) building elevations.
