The Independent Consultation on Options for Meeting the Electrical Supply Needs of the Gainesville Community (B)

Explanation: At the February 2, 2006 Special City Commission meeting, the Commission directed us to provide an analysis of a natural gas combined cycle (NGCC) energy supply plan option that is comparable to the analysis performed by ICF on the four other energy supply options selected by the City Commission for study. We were also directed to work with ICF to prepare customers utility bills under each of the five options. While ICF is able to provide the costs associated with power supply, we need to provide the balance of system costs (transmission, distribution, etc.) and the underlying rate structure assumptions. Although we are coordinating closely with ICF to set up the appropriate models etc., we can not finalize the analysis of the NGCC energy plan option, or the utility bill comparisons across the options, until we receive ICF's final report on March 1. We plan to provide these results to the City Commission as soon as possible and will present the results at the March 6 special City Commission meeting.

Fiscal Note: There is no immediate fiscal impact from the above recommendations.

RECOMMENDATION

The City Commission: 1) Hear a presentation from ICF Consulting on the results of their final report; 2) Hear a presentation from utility staff on the results from evaluating the natural gas combined cycle option and the relative effects of all five energy supply plan options on customer's bills; and 3) Provide direction to utility staff on options for meeting the electrical supply needs of the Gainesville community.
