WHEREAS, this date is designated to recall and reflect and remember all members of the transgender community who have been victims of violence; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Gainesville, Florida, are committed to tolerance, understanding, compassion and acceptance of diversity; and

WHEREAS, Pride Community Center of North Central Florida provides education, resources and programs to recognize the "National Transgender Day of Remembrance."
